A bill to amend 1953 PA 232, entitled

"Corrections code of 1953,"

(MCL 791.201 to 791.285) by adding section 62d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

SEC. 62D. (1) UNLESS THERE ARE SPECIFIC CIRCUMSTANCES 1 2 PREVENTING IT FROM DOING SO, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ENSURE THAT 3 PRISONERS IN THE CUSTODY OF THE DEPARTMENT WHO ARE APPROXIMATELY 17 4 TO 22 YEARS OF AGE ARE HOUSED ONLY WITH OTHER PRISONERS WHO ARE 5 APPROXIMATELY 17 TO 22 YEARS OF AGE. UNLESS THERE ARE SPECIFIC 6 CIRCUMSTANCES PREVENTING IT FROM DOING SO, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ALSO ENSURE THAT THE PRISONERS DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION ARE 7 HOUSED IN THE SAME CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES IN THIS STATE. 8

9 (2) AT A FACILITY HOUSING PRISONERS UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE 10 DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE, TO THE EXTENT IT IS ABLE TO DO SO,

PROGRAMMING DESIGNED FOR YOUTH REHABILITATION. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL

5 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "CORRECTIONAL FACILITY" MEANS A 6 FACILITY OPERATED BY THE DEPARTMENT, OR BY A PRIVATE ENTITY UNDER 7 CONTRACT WITH THE DEPARTMENT, THAT HOUSES PRISONERS UNDER THE 8 JURISDICTION OF THE DEPARTMENT.

9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days10 after the date it is enacted into law.
