

SENATE BILL No. 1004

May 31, 2016, Introduced by Senators WARREN, ANANICH, HOOD, BIEDA, HERTEL and KNEZEK and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

A bill to amend 1936 (Ex Sess) PA 1, entitled "Michigan employment security act," (MCL 421.1 to 421.75) by adding section 62a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 62A. THE UNEMPLOYMENT AGENCY SHALL MAKE AN ANNUAL REPORT
2 TO THE LEGISLATURE CONCERNING UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFIT FRAUD CASES. THE
3 FIRST REPORT SHALL COVER EACH OF THE 3 PREVIOUS 12-MONTH PERIODS,
4 AND SUBSEQUENT REPORTS SHALL COVER THE PREVIOUS 12-MONTH PERIOD.

5 EACH REPORT SHALL INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- 6 (A) THE NUMBER OF FRAUD DETERMINATIONS.
- 7 (B) THE NUMBER OF FRAUD DETERMINATIONS APPEALED.
- 8 (C) THE NUMBER OF FRAUD CASES ADJUDICATED AND THE OUTCOME OF
- 9 THOSE ADJUDICATIONS.
- 10 (D) THE TOTAL COST TO THE UNEMPLOYMENT AGENCY OF THE FRAUD

1 PROCEEDINGS, INCLUDING COSTS ATTRIBUTABLE TO STAFF.

2 (E) THE TOTAL PROCEEDS ATTRIBUTED TO FRAUD CASES FROM
3 RESTITUTION, INTEREST, AND PENALTIES.

4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
5 after the date it is enacted into law.
