

SENATE BILL No. 1032

September 6, 2016, Introduced by Senators WARREN and HUNE and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 2006 PA 110, entitled
"Michigan zoning enabling act,"
(MCL 125.3101 to 125.3702) by adding section 205b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 205B. A LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT SHALL NOT ADOPT OR
2 ENFORCE PROVISIONS THAT REGULATE RAISING OF LIVESTOCK IN URBAN AND
3 SUBURBAN AREAS UNLESS THE ZONING ORDINANCE PROVISIONS MEET BOTH OF
4 THE FOLLOWING:

5 (A) ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE GUIDELINES ESTABLISHED BY THE
6 COMMISSION OF AGRICULTURE AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT IN SECTION 4 OF THE
7 URBAN AGRICULTURE ACT.

8 (B) ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE MICHIGAN RIGHT TO FARM ACT, 1981
9 PA 93, MCL 286.471 TO 286.474, AND THE GENERALLY ACCEPTED

1 **AGRICULTURAL AND MANAGEMENT PRACTICES ADOPTED UNDER THAT ACT.**

2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
3 after the date it is enacted into law.

4 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
5 unless Senate Bill No. 1031

6 of the 98th Legislature is enacted into law.
