

SENATE BILL No. 1185

November 30, 2016, Introduced by Senators HOPGOOD, ANANICH, KNEZEK, JOHNSON, BIEDA and GREGORY and referred to the Committee on Families, Seniors and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled
"The social welfare act,"
(MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 57cc.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 57CC. (1) IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER REASON A FAMILY MAY BE
2 OFFERED PAYMENT ASSISTANCE UNDER THE CHILD DEVELOPMENT AND CARE
3 PROGRAM, PAYMENT ASSISTANCE SHALL BE OFFERED WHEN A PARENT IS
4 UNABLE TO PROVIDE CHILD CARE DUE TO HIS OR HER ATTENDING LAW
5 SCHOOL, MEDICAL SCHOOL, OR GRADUATE SCHOOL.

6 (2) THE ACTIVITIES DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1) SHALL BE
7 APPROVED ACTIVITIES UNDER THE CHILD DEVELOPMENT AND CARE PROGRAM
8 AND ARE IN ADDITION TO ANY ACTIVITIES THAT ARE CURRENTLY APPROVED
9 ACTIVITIES UNDER THAT PROGRAM.

10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days

1 after the date it is enacted into law.
