by amending section 215 (MCL 750.215), as amended by 2003 PA 15.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 215. (1) An individual who is not a peace officer or a
 medical examiner shall not do any of the following:

3 (a) Perform the duties of a peace officer or a medical4 examiner.

5 (b) Represent to another person that he or she is a peace6 officer or a medical examiner for any unlawful purpose.

(c) Represent to another person that he or she is a peace officer or a medical examiner with the intent to compel the person to do or refrain from doing any act against his or her will.

(2) Except as provided in subsection (3), an individual who
 violates subsection (1) is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by
 imprisonment for not more than 1 year or a fine of not more than
 \$1,000.00, or both.

5 (3) An individual who, in violation of subsection (1),
6 performs the duties of a peace officer to commit or attempt to
7 commit a crime or represents to another person that he or she is a
8 peace officer to commit or attempt to commit a crime is guilty of a
9 felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 4 years or a
10 fine of not more than \$5,000.00, or both.

(4) A sentence imposed under subsection (3) may be ordered to
be served consecutively to any term of imprisonment imposed for
another violation arising from the same transaction.

Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days 18 19 after the date it is enacted into law.
