

HOUSE BILL No. 4966

September 14, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Glenn and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to limit liability for the reporting of suspicious activity or behavior.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "see
2 something say something act".

3 Sec. 2. As used in this act, "report of suspicious activity or
4 behavior" means a communication to a law enforcement agency or
5 other appropriate authority of the behavior or activity of another
6 individual that is made with the reasonable belief that the
7 behavior or activity constitutes, or is in furtherance of, a crime
8 or act of terrorism.

9 Sec. 3. (1) An individual who in good faith makes a report of
10 suspicious activity or behavior is immune from civil and criminal
11 liability that arises out of the making of the report.

1 (2) This section does not apply if the individual
2 intentionally makes the report knowing it to be false or if the
3 individual makes the report with reckless disregard for the truth
4 of the report.

5 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
6 date it is enacted into law.
