

HOUSE BILL No. 5130

October 17, 2017, Introduced by Rep. Roberts and referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," by amending section 811f (MCL 257.811f), as amended by 2006 PA 562.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 811f. (1) ~~The~~**EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS**
2 **SUBSECTION, THE** secretary of state may, upon application, issue 1
3 fund-raising plate instead of a standard registration plate to a
4 person for use on a passenger motor vehicle or motor home or a
5 pickup truck or van used exclusively to transport personal
6 possessions or family members for nonbusiness purposes. **THE**
7 **SECRETARY OF STATE MAY, UPON APPLICATION, ISSUE THE AGRICULTURAL**
8 **HERITAGE FUND-RAISING PLATE CREATED IN SECTION 811N INSTEAD OF A**

1 STANDARD REGISTRATION PLATE TO A PERSON FOR USE ON A PASSENGER
2 MOTOR VEHICLE, A MOTOR HOME, A PICKUP TRUCK OR VAN USED EXCLUSIVELY
3 TO TRANSPORT PERSONAL POSSESSIONS OR FAMILY MEMBERS FOR NONBUSINESS
4 PURPOSES, A VEHICLE USED IN AN AGRIBUSINESS OPERATION, OR A
5 COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE.

6 (2) A person may be issued a fund-raising plate for use on a
7 vehicle under this act by applying to the secretary of state
8 ~~pursuant to~~ **UNDER** section 217. An application for an original fund-
9 raising plate shall be accompanied by a \$25.00 fund-raising
10 donation, payment of the regular vehicle registration tax
11 prescribed under this act, and a \$10.00 service fee. An application
12 for renewal of a fund-raising plate shall be accompanied by payment
13 of the vehicle registration tax required under section 801 and a
14 \$10.00 fund-raising donation. Application for a replacement fund-
15 raising plate shall be accompanied by payment of only the fee
16 prescribed under section 804.

17 (3) The secretary of state may issue a personalized fund-
18 raising plate upon application and the payment of the personalized
19 registration plate fee prescribed under section 803b in addition to
20 the fees and donations prescribed under subsection (2) and the
21 regular vehicle registration tax prescribed under this act.

22 (4) A disabled person who applies for a fund-raising plate
23 under this section and who pays the required service fees shall be
24 issued, as determined by the secretary of state, a disabled
25 person's plate as provided in section 803d for his or her fund-
26 raising plate. The secretary of state shall require the same proof
27 that the applicant is a disabled person as is required for issuance

1 of a permanent windshield placard under section 675.

2 (5) A fund-raising plate expires ~~pursuant to~~ **AS PROVIDED IN**
3 section 226. The secretary of state may issue a tab or tabs
4 designating the month and year of expiration for an original or
5 renewal fund-raising plate.

6 (6) The secretary of state may issue a temporary registration
7 permit to a person who submits an application and the proper fees
8 and donation for a fund-raising plate, if the applicant's current
9 vehicle registration will expire before his or her receipt of a
10 fund-raising plate. The temporary registration ~~shall expire~~ **EXPIRES**
11 upon the applicant's receipt of a fund-raising plate or upon the
12 expiration of 30 days after the date of issuance, whichever occurs
13 first. The temporary permit shall be issued without a separate fee.

14 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
15 after the date it is enacted into law.
