A bill to amend 2016 PA 235, entitled "Public threat alert system act," by amending section 4 (MCL 28.674).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 4. (1) A person shall not intentionally make a false

report of a public threat, or intentionally cause a false report of a public threat to be made, to a peace officer, police agency of this state or of a local unit of government, 9-1-1 operator, or any other governmental employee or contractor or employee of a contractor who is authorized to receive the report, knowing that the report is false. A person who violates this section is guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment for not more than 4 years or a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, \$4,000.00, or both.

- 2 to pay to the state or a local unit of government and the media the
- 3 costs of responding to the false report or threat, including, but
- 4 not limited to, the use of police or fire emergency response
- 5 vehicles and teams, under section 1f of chapter IX of the code of
- 6 criminal procedure, 1927 PA 175, MCL 769.1f.
- 7 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 8 after the date it is enacted into law.
