THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 509w. (1) The person processing an application submitted in person at a department of state office, a designated voter registration agency, or the office of a county clerk shall do all BOTH of the following:
 - (a) Validate the application in the manner prescribed by the secretary of state.
 - (b) Issue a receipt to the applicant verifying the acceptance of the application.
 - (2) THE PERSON PROCESSING AN APPLICATION SUBMITTED ELECTRONICALLY UNDER SECTION 509V SHALL DO BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING:
 - (A) VALIDATE THE APPLICATION IN THE MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE
