## **HOUSE BILL No. 5356**

A bill to amend 1919 PA 339, entitled "Dog law of 1919,"

by amending section 9 (MCL 287.269), as amended by 2000 PA 438.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 9. (1) Each dog license issued under this act shall
  display all of the following:
- 3 (a) An expiration date. Subject to section 6(4), the
