HOUSE BILL No. 5458

January 30, 2018, Introduced by Rep. Cochran and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," by amending sections 74116 and 78119 (MCL 324.74116 and 324.78119), section 74116 as amended by 2016 PA 1 and section 78119 as amended by 2013 PA 81.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 74116. (1) Subject to subsection (4), the operator of a nonresident motor vehicle or commercial motor vehicle shall not enter any state park with that motor vehicle unless a valid motor vehicle park permit issued under section 74117 is affixed to the lower right-hand corner of the windshield. An annual motor vehicle park permit for a nonresident motor vehicle shall must be affixed permanently for that year. The department shall post signs at parks

- 1 that state that a motor vehicle park permit is required for entry
- 2 by a nonresident motor vehicle or commercial motor vehicle.
- 3 (2) Subject to subsection (4), the operator of a resident
- 4 motor vehicle shall not enter a state park with the resident motor
- 5 vehicle unless the recreation passport fee has been paid for that
- 6 motor vehicle. Payment of the recreation passport fee authorizes
- 7 entry into all state parks and recreation areas and designated
- 8 state-operated public boating access sites until expiration of the
- 9 motor vehicle registration.
- 10 (3) Subject to subsection (4), if the secretary of state
- 11 issues registration tabs or stickers as described in section 805 of
- 12 the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.805, the operator
- 13 of a resident motor vehicle shall not enter a state park with the
- 14 resident motor vehicle unless the resident motor vehicle has a
- 15 registration tab or sticker marked as provided under that section
- 16 to show that the recreation passport fee has been paid.
- 17 (4) Subsections (1) to (3) do not apply under any of the
- 18 following circumstances:
- 19 (a) While the motor vehicle is being driven or parked within
- 20 an established federal, state, or county highway within a state
- **21** park.
- 22 (b) If the motor vehicle is used in the operation or
- 23 maintenance of a state park, is an emergency motor vehicle, is a
- 24 state owned or law enforcement motor vehicle, or is a private motor
- 25 vehicle being operated on official state business.
- (c) If the motor vehicle is registered under section 803e(1)
- 27 of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.803e, and is

- 1 exempt under section 803e(6) of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA
- 2 300, MCL 257.803e, from the registration tax, or if the motor
- 3 vehicle is registered under section 217d or 803f of the Michigan
- 4 vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.217d and 257.803f.
- 5 (d) At a state-operated public boating access site or a state
- 6 park where there is an opportunity to fish on a day that the
- 7 department has designated as a free winter fishing day or a free
- 8 fishing day under section 43534.
- **9** (e) If and to the extent that the department waives the
- 10 requirements for department-sponsored events or other circumstances
- 11 as determined by the director or the director's designee.
- 12 (F) AT A STATE PARK OR RECREATION AREA ON PUBLIC LANDS DAY.
- Sec. 78119. (1) Subject to subsection (4), a person shall not
- 14 enter, in a nonresident motor vehicle or commercial motor vehicle,
- 15 a state-operated public boating access site designated under
- 16 section 78105(2) without a valid pass affixed to the lower right-
- 17 hand corner of the windshield. A seasonal pass shall be affixed
- 18 permanently for the season.
- 19 (2) Subject to subsection (4), the operator of a resident
- 20 motor vehicle shall not enter a state-operated public boating
- 21 access site designated under section 78105(2) with the resident
- 22 motor vehicle unless the recreation passport fee has been paid for
- 23 that motor vehicle. Payment of the recreation passport fee
- 24 authorizes entry into all state parks and recreation areas and
- 25 designated state-operated public boating access sites until
- 26 expiration of the motor vehicle registration.
- 27 (3) Subject to subsection (4), if the secretary of state

- 1 issues registration tabs or stickers as described in section 805 of
- 2 the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.805, the operator
- 3 of a resident motor vehicle shall not enter a designated state-
- 4 operated public boating access site with the resident motor vehicle
- 5 unless the resident motor vehicle has a registration tab or sticker
- 6 marked as provided under that section to show that the recreation
- 7 passport fee has been paid.
- **8** (4) Subsections (1) to (3) do not apply under any of the
- 9 following circumstances:
- 10 (a) If the motor vehicle is used in the operation or
- 11 maintenance of the public boating access site, is an emergency
- 12 motor vehicle, is a state-owned or law enforcement motor vehicle,
- 13 or is a private motor vehicle being operated on official state
- 14 business.
- **15** (b) If the motor vehicle is registered under section 803e(1)
- 16 of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.803e, and is
- 17 exempt under section 803e(6) of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA
- 18 300, MCL 257.803e, from the registration tax, or if the motor
- 19 vehicle is registered under section 217d or 803f of the Michigan
- 20 vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.217d and 257.803f.
- 21 (c) If and to the extent the department waives the
- 22 requirements for department-sponsored events or other circumstances
- 23 as determined by the director or the director's designee.
- 24 (D) AT A STATE-OPERATED PUBLIC BOATING ACCESS SITE ON PUBLIC
- 25 LANDS DAY.
- 26 (5) A person who violates subsection (1), (2), or (3) is
- 27 responsible for a state civil infraction and may be ordered to pay

- 1 a civil fine of not more than \$100.00. A person shall MUST not be
- 2 cited for a violation of both subsections (2) and (3) for the same
- 3 incident.
- 4 (6) In any proceeding for the violation of this part or a rule
- 5 promulgated under this part, if a motor vehicle is found parked in
- 6 a designated state-operated public boating access site, the
- 7 registration plate displayed on the motor vehicle constitutes prima
- 8 facie evidence that the owner of the motor vehicle was the person
- 9 who parked or placed it at the location where it was found.
- 10 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 11 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 12 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 13 unless Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 5457 (request no.
- 14 03355'17) of the 99th Legislature is enacted into law.
