April 25, 2018, Introduced by Rep. LaFave and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 220, entitled "Persons with disabilities civil rights act," (MCL 37.1101 to 37.1607) by adding section 102a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 102A. (1) THE CIVIL RIGHTS COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT AND
- 2 POST ON THE DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL RIGHTS' WEBSITE A STANDARDIZED
- 3 DESIGN THAT IS A VARIATION OF THE CURRENT INTERNATIONAL SYMBOL OF
- 4 ACCESSIBILITY. THE DESIGN MUST DEPICT A DYNAMIC CHARACTER LEANING
- 5 FORWARD IN A WHEELCHAIR WITH A SENSE OF MOVEMENT. THE DESIGN MUST
- 6 BE SIMPLE, AVOID ANY SECONDARY MEANING, AND FACILITATE
- 7 ACCESSIBILITY TO A DEGREE EQUIVALENT TO THE EXISTING UNIVERSAL
- 8 SYMBOL OF ACCESS. IT MUST NOT INCLUDE ANY WRITTEN WORDS, SUCH AS
- 9 "HANDICAPPED", OR ANY OTHER DESIGNATION OR INFORMATION.
