

# HOUSE BILL No. 6416

September 27, 2018, Introduced by Reps. Howrylak, Runestad and LaGrand and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to recognize November 25 of each year as the Michigan day of remembrance of the Holodomor.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 1. The legislature declares that November 25 of each year  
2 shall be the Michigan day of remembrance of the Holodomor, the  
3 Ukrainian genocide of 1932-1933, and that the period beginning on  
4 the Sunday before that day through the following Sunday shall be  
5 days of remembrance in this state in memory of the victims of the  
6 genocide and in honor of the survivors.

7           Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the  
8 date it is enacted into law.
