## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION K

A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by amending section 7 of article IX, to provide for a graduated state income tax.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to provide for a graduated state income tax, is proposed, agreed to, and submitted to the people of the state:

- 1 ARTICLE IX
- 2 Sec. 7. No AN income tax graduated as to rate or base shall
- 3 MAY be imposed by the state or any of its subdivisions.BUT SHALL
- 4 NOT BE IMPOSED BY ANY SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE.
- 5 Resolved further, That the foregoing amendment shall be
- 6 submitted to the people of the state at the next general election
- 7 in the manner provided by law.
