SUMMARY:

House Bills 5893 and 5894 would prohibit the Marijuana Regulatory Agency from promulgating or enforcing a departmental rule that would prohibit a person that holds a state operating license for medical marijuana or that is licensed to operate a marijuana establishment from donating money to a nonprofit organization or from sponsoring, supporting, or donating money to a substance use disorder education program for youth.

House Bill 5893 would amend the Medical Marijuana Facilities Licensing Act, which regulates the medical marijuana market.

House Bill 5894 would amend the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marijuana Act, which regulates the adult-use (recreational) marijuana market.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bills 5893 and 5894 would not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (which houses the Marijuana Regulatory Agency) or any other unit of state or local government.
