

# HOUSE BILL NO. 5314

January 09, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Markkanen, Paquette, Bellino and LaFave and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1909 PA 283, entitled

"An act to revise, consolidate, and add to the laws relating to the establishment, opening, discontinuing, vacating, closing, altering, improvement, maintenance, and use of the public highways and private roads; the condemnation of property and gravel therefor; the building, repairing and preservation of bridges; maintaining public access to waterways under certain conditions; setting and protecting shade trees, drainage, and cutting weeds and brush within this state; providing for the election or appointment and defining the powers, duties, and compensation of state, county, township, and district highway officials; and to prescribe penalties and provide remedies,"

by amending section 10 of chapter IV (MCL 224.10), as amended by



1 advertise for sealed proposals for the purchase of passenger

5 (4) Each county road commission shall take all reasonable  
6 steps to ensure minority business enterprises have the equal

10 (5) A county road commission may enter into a contract or  
11 agreement for the purchase of real or personal property for public  
12 purposes, to be paid for in installments over a period not to  
13 exceed ~~15~~30 years or the useful life of the property acquired,  
14 whichever is less. Real or personal property purchased under this  
15 act may serve as collateral in support of the purchase, contract,  
16 or agreement.
