

HOUSE BILL No. 4690

June 5, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Hope, Wittenberg, Elder, Pagan, Brixie, Kuppa, Anthony and Gay-Dagnogo and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 372, entitled

"An act to regulate and license the selling, purchasing, possessing, and carrying of certain firearms, gas ejecting devices, and electro-muscular disruption devices; to prohibit the buying, selling, or carrying of certain firearms, gas ejecting devices, and electro-muscular disruption devices without a license or other authorization; to provide for the forfeiture of firearms and electro-muscular disruption devices under certain circumstances; to provide for penalties and remedies; to provide immunity from civil liability under certain circumstances; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local agencies; to prohibit certain conduct against individuals who apply for or receive a license to carry a concealed pistol; to make appropriations; to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations; and to repeal all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act,"

(MCL 28.421 to 28.435) by adding section 2c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

SEC. 2C. (1) A RECOGNIZED TARGET RANGE OR SHOOTING FACILITY SHALL NOT RENT, LEASE, OR LOAN A FIREARM TO AN INDIVIDUAL UNLESS

1 THE TARGET RANGE OR SHOOTING FACILITY HAS VERIFIED 1 OF THE
2 FOLLOWING:

3 (A) THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS NOT PROHIBITED UNDER FEDERAL LAW
4 FROM POSSESSING A FIREARM BY PERFORMING A BACKGROUND CHECK THROUGH
5 THE FEDERAL NATIONAL INSTANT CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECK SYSTEM.

6 (B) THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS LICENSED TO CARRY A CONCEALED
7 PISTOL UNDER SECTION 5B.

8 (C) THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HAS A VALID LICENSE ISSUED UNDER
9 SECTION 2.

10 (2) A RECOGNIZED TARGET RANGE OR SHOOTING FACILITY THAT
11 VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1), OR WHOSE EMPLOYEE VIOLATES SUBSECTION (1),
12 IS RESPONSIBLE FOR A STATE CIVIL INFRACTION AND MAY BE ORDERED TO
13 PAY A CIVIL FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00.
