

# HOUSE BILL NO. 4725

June 13, 2019, Introduced by Reps. Peterson, Hammoud, Guerra, Rabhi, Bolden, Sowerby, Manoogian, Pagan, Elder, Gay-Dagnogo, LaGrand, Anthony, Robinson and Sabo and referred to the Committee on Military, Veterans and Homeland Security.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"  
(MCL 760.1 to 777.69) by adding section 5 to chapter XVI.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

CHAPTER XVI

1  
2           **Sec. 5. A law enforcement agency shall not adopt or implement**  
3 **a policy that permits a peace officer to stop and search a person**  
4 **unless that policy conforms to the following:**

5           **(a) The stop is for investigative purposes and the peace**



1 officer has reasonable suspicion to believe the person has been,  
2 is, or is about to be engaged in criminal activity.

3 (b) The search is of a person stopped for investigative  
4 purposes and the peace officer has reasonable suspicion to believe  
5 that the person is armed and dangerous.

6 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
7 after the date it is enacted into law.
