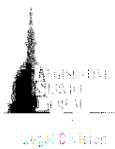

PART 2

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

GENERAL SECTIONS

8 Sec. 201. In accordance with section 30 of article IX of the
9 state constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources
10 in this appropriation act for the fiscal year ending September 30,
11 2020 is \$500,000.00 and state spending from state sources to be
12 paid to local units of government is \$0.00.

13 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
14 under this act and the departments, commissions, boards, offices,
15 and programs for which appropriations are made under this act are
16 subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
17 to 18.1594.

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES

19 Sec. 301. From the funds appropriated in part 1 for senior
20 citizen center program grants, the department shall allocate
21 \$500,000.00 for a grant program administered by the aging and adult
22 services agency to support health-related senior programs at
23 multipurpose senior citizen centers. Program goals shall include
24 mental and physical health maintenance and improvement for senior
25 participants. Grant awards shall not exceed \$5,000.00 for a
26 program. Grantees are encouraged to match the funding with
27 participant fees or other nonstate source of funds. A private
28 housing facility with senior activity programs is not eligible for
29 the grant program.
