## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 539c. (1) Any A person who is present or who is not
- 2 present during a private conversation and who wilfully willfully
- 3 uses any device to eavesdrop upon the conversation without the
- 4 consent of all parties thereto, to the conversation, or who





- 1 knowingly aids, employs or procures another person to do the same
- 2 in violation of violate this section, is guilty of a felony
- 3 punishable by imprisonment in a state prison for not more than 2
- 4 years or by a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, or both.
- 5 (2) This section does not apply to the use of any device for
- 6 purposes of security monitoring in a residence if conducted in
- 7 conformity with section 539d.
