

# HOUSE BILL NO. 5421

January 28, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Filler, Steven Johnson, LaFave, Wozniak, Rendon, Bolden and Kahle and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled  
"The Michigan penal code,"  
by amending section 539c (MCL 750.539c).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1           Sec. 539c. (1) ~~Any~~**A** person who is present or who is not  
2 present during a private conversation ~~and who wilfully~~**willfully**  
3 uses any device to eavesdrop upon the conversation without the  
4 consent of all parties ~~thereto,~~**to the conversation**, or who



1 knowingly aids, employs or procures another person to ~~do the same~~  
2 ~~in violation of~~ **violate** this section, is guilty of a felony  
3 punishable by imprisonment ~~in a state prison~~ for not more than 2  
4 years or by a fine of not more than \$2,000.00, or both.

5 **(2) This section does not apply to the use of any device for**  
6 **purposes of security monitoring in a residence if conducted in**  
7 **conformity with section 539d.**
