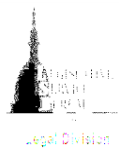

8 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

9 GENERAL SECTIONS

10 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state  
 11 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under  
 12 part 1 for fiscal year 2019-2020 is \$3,000,000.00 and state  
 13 spending from state sources to be paid to local units of government  
 14 for fiscal year 2019-2020 is \$3,000,000.00.

15 Sec. 202. The appropriations authorized under this part and  
 16 part 1 are subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431,  
 17 MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

19 DEPARTMENT OF STATE

20 Sec. 301. Funds appropriated in part 1 shall be distributed to  
 21 cities, villages, and townships and shall be used to purchase high-  
 22 speed tabulators and other equipment to accommodate the increase in  
 23 absentee ballots. Additional equipment is necessary to ensure that  
 24 votes on absentee ballots are tabulated in accordance with the  
 25 intent of the voters.
