## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5475**

February 06, 2020, Introduced by Reps. Love, Garrett, Hope, Tyrone Carter, Brenda Carter, Cynthia Johnson, Tate, Bolden, Yancey, Byrd and Jones and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to require the establishment of a task force on the licensing of adult entertainment establishments and performers; and to provide for the powers and duties of certain state governmental officers and entities.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1. As used in this act, "department" means the department
 of licensing and regulatory affairs.





- 1 Sec. 3. (1) The department shall establish a task force to
- 2 develop and recommend statewide standards for the licensing and
- 3 regulation of adult entertainment establishments and short-term
- 4 adult entertainment venues and engagements, and the licensing of
- 5 adult entertainment performers, including, but not limited to,
- 6 recommendations concerning all of the following:
- 7 (a) For the licensing of performers, a minimum age
- 8 requirement, safety training pre-requisites, and medical
- 9 requirements, including, but not limited to, general physical exams
- 10 before licensure or license renewal.
- 11 (b) For the licensing and regulation of establishments and
- 12 short-term venues and engagements, all of the following:
- 13 (i) Standards for licensing of the venue of an adult
- 14 entertainment establishment, including, but not limited to, minimal
- 15 structural, safety, and liability insurance requirements.
- 16 (ii) Standards for licensing of a short-term adult
- 17 entertainment venue.
- 18 (iii) Standards for licensing of the owner and managers of an
- 19 adult entertainment establishment. As used in this subparagraph,
- 20 "owner" includes an individual, partnership, corporation,
- 21 association, or other legal entity.
- 22 (iv) Standards for licensing of short-term adult entertainment
- 23 engagements undertaken by an adult entertainment performer or
- 24 performers.
- 25 (c) Licensing fees for all of the following:
- 26 (i) Performers, owners, and managers of adult entertainment
- 27 establishments.
- 28 (ii) Short-term adult entertainment venues.
- 29 (iii) Short-term adult entertainment engagements.



- 1 (d) License renewal and inspection timelines for all of the 2 following:
- 3 (i) Performers, owners, and managers of adult entertainment4 establishments.
- 5 (ii) Adult entertainment establishments.
- 6 (e) Penalties and fines for violation of the recommended7 licensing standards as they apply to each of the following:
- 8 (i) Performers, owners, and managers of adult entertainment 9 establishments.
- 10 (ii) Adult entertainment establishments.
- 11 (iii) Short-term venues for adult entertainment.
- 12 (2) Subject to subsection (3), the task force shall consist of 13 the following members appointed by the governor:
- (a) A representative of the department as an ex officio member
  without a vote. The representative of the department shall serve as
  chair of the task force.
- 17 (b) The state treasurer, or his or her designee, as an ex
  18 officio member without a vote.
- (c) The director of the department of state police.
- (d) The director of the law department of the city of Detroit,or his or her designee.
- (e) One police officer of the police department of the city ofDetroit, appointed by the mayor of Detroit.
- 24 (f) Three current or former performers who work or worked in 25 the adult entertainment industry.
- 26 (g) Three current or former owners of adult entertainment
  27 establishments.
- (h) Three current or former managers of adult entertainmentestablishments.

- 1 (3) The members of the task force described in subsection 2 (2)(f), (g), and (h) shall be appointed in accordance with the
- 3 following:
- 4 (a) The senate majority leader, the senate minority leader,
- 5 the speaker of the house of representatives, and the minority
- 6 leader of the house of representatives shall each recommend to the
- 7 governor 2 individuals from each of the categories listed in
- 8 subsection (2)(f), (g), and (h).
- **9** (b) The governor shall select 1 individual from each of the 2
- 10 individuals recommended by the legislative leaders described in
- 11 subdivision (a) for each of the categories described in that
- 12 subdivision for a total of 4 candidates for each category. The
- 13 governor shall appoint 3 of the 4 candidates in each category to
- 14 serve on the task force.
- 15 Sec. 5. The task force shall present a report of its
- 16 recommendations to the governor, the speaker of the house, the
- 17 senate majority leader, and the chairs of the house and senate
- 18 regulatory reform committees not later than 1 year after the date
- 19 of its establishment.
- 20 Sec. 7. At the time the report described in section 5 is
- 21 presented, the department shall provide a list of all adult
- 22 entertainment establishments in this state that includes
- 23 information on business hours, whether the establishment serves
- 24 food and alcohol, whether the establishment has private rooms,
- 25 booths, or suites, and the employment status of the performers that
- 26 perform at the listed establishment.
