THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. (1) An individual who has sustained either of the 2 following is dead:
- 3 (a) Irreversible cessation of circulatory and respiratory4 functions.
- 5 (b) Irreversible cessation of all functions of the entire





- 1 brain, including the brain stem.
- (2) A determination of death shall must be made in accordance
 with accepted medical standards.
- 4 (3) A physician or registered nurse may pronounce the death of
 5 a person an individual in accordance with this act. This subsection
- 6 does not prohibit a health facility or agency licensed under
- 7 article 17 of the public health code, Act No. 368 of the Public
- 8 Acts of 1978, being sections 333.20101 to 333.22260 of the Michigan
- 9 Compiled Laws, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.20101 to 333.21925, from
- 10 determining which of its medical personnel may pronounce the death
- 11 of a person an individual in that health facility or agency.
