THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1526b. (1) Not later than 1 year after the effective date of the amendatory act that added this section, the department, in conjunction with the department of health and human services, shall develop or adopt a professional development course for teachers on mental health first aid.
