- 6 (d) Certification of a mediator in a tax dispute described in7 subdivision (c).

- 9 (2) The tribunal does not have exclusive or original

- 11 a decision on that matter is a necessary predicate to determining a

- 24 of the fair housing act, title VIII of the civil rights act of
- 25 1968, Public Law 90-284, 82 Stat 81.
