## **SENATE BILL NO. 1033**

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled "The social welfare act,"

(MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 109n.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 109n. (1) Beginning October 1, 2020, a pregnant woman
- 2 with an annual household income between 133% and 185% of the
- 3 federal poverty guidelines who is eligible for and receiving
- 4 medical assistance at the time her pregnancy ends may continue
- 5 receiving medical assistance for pregnancy-related or postpartum
- 6 services for 12 months after the pregnancy ends.

- 1 (2) The postpartum extension is available for 12 months
- 2 beginning the day the pregnancy ends and includes any remaining
- 3 days in that twelfth month. The day the pregnancy ends includes,
- 4 but is not limited to, the date of a live birth, miscarriage, or
- 5 stillbirth.
- 6 (3) The postpartum extension of medical assistance services is 7 available to a woman to whom all of the following apply:
- 8 (a) Was eligible for and receiving medical assistance on the 9 day the pregnancy ended.
- 10 (b) Meets the nonfinancial eligibility factors to receive 11 medical assistance.
- 12 (c) Is not currently eligible for medical assistance under
- 13 another medical assistance program other than the postpartum
- 14 benefits under this section.
