- (b) "Minor" means an individual under 18 years of age who isnot emancipated under section 4 of 1968 PA 293, MCL 722.4.

- (c) "Question" means any inquiry for information in a criminal 1 2 investigation.
- 3 Sec. 3. (1) A law enforcement officer shall not question a 4 minor or an individual the officer has reason to believe is a minor 5 unless the officer first obtains consent to the questioning from
- the minor's parent or guardian. 6

(2) A law enforcement agency shall develop policies and 7 procedures to ensure compliance with subsection (1).
