- 3 Whereas, The term "Gold Star" began during World War I when
- 4 American families displayed flags in homes, businesses, schools,
- 5 and churches with a gold star for each loved one lost in military
- 6 service; and
- 7 Whereas, Today, the nation recognizes the sacrifices that all
- 8 "Gold Star Family" members make when a father, mother, husband,
- 9 wife, brother, sister, son, daughter or other loved one dies in
- 10 active service to the nation; and
- 11 Whereas, Fewer than one percent of our nation serves in our

- 1 military, and we have an obligation to acknowledge the losses of
- 2 our service men and women, and to ensure that their families are
- 3 not forgotten; and
- 4 Whereas, Commemoration of the 50th Anniversary of the Vietnam
- 5 War is May 28, 2012-November 11, 2025, and we would like to
- 6 specifically thank the families of the Vietnam War veterans who
- 7 paid the ultimate sacrifice. They are memorialized at the Vietnam
- 8 Veterans Memorial, also known as The Wall, in our Nation's Capital,
- 9 Washington, D.C.; and
- 10 Whereas, September 20-26, 2020 has been designated "Gold Star
- 11 Family Week"; now, therefore, be it
- 12 Resolved by the Senate, That members of this legislative body
- 13 designate September 20-26, 2020, as "Gold Star Family Week." We
- 14 encourage all Michigan Citizens to honor Gold Star Families.
