The Speaker, on behalf of the entire membership of the House of Representatives, offered the following resolution:

- 1 A resolution of tribute offered as a memorial for Lawrence B.
- 2 Lindemer, former member of the House of Representatives.
- 3 Whereas, The members of this legislative body were saddened to
- 4 hear of the passing of Lawrence "Larry" Lindemer. With his sharp
- 5 mind and legal acumen, he diligently represented his constituents
- 6 in Ingham County during his two years of service in the House of
- 7 Representatives; and
- 8 Whereas, Lawrence Lindemer was born in Syracuse, New York,
- 9 later settling in Stockbridge, Michigan, which he would call home
- 10 for decades. He received undergraduate and legal degrees from the
- 11 University of Michigan in preparation for his future legal career.
- 12 In between earning those degrees, he served his country as a second

- 1 lieutenant in the U.S. Army Air Forces during World War II. He
- 2 worked as an assistant prosecuting attorney for Ingham County in

- 3 1949 and 1950, the year of his election to the House of
- 4 Representatives; and
- 5 Whereas, From 1951 to 1952, Lawrence Lindemer served in this
- 6 legislative body as the representative for the then Second District
- 7 of Ingham County. His intellect and talents were put to good use,
- 8 as he worked on a wide array of policy issues as a member of the
- 9 Educational Institutions, Geological Survey, Judiciary, Juvenile
- 10 Corrections, Retirement, and Revision and Amendment of the
- 11 Constitution standing committees; and
- 12 Whereas, Lawrence Lindemer continued his eminently
- 13 distinguished career after his time in the Legislature. He served
- 14 on the Hoover Commission to recommend administrative changes in the
- 15 federal government in the early to mid-1950s. Upon leaving
- 16 Washington, D.C., and returning to Michigan, his accomplishments
- 17 progressed back home. Michigan Supreme Court Justice, University of
- 18 Michigan Regent, and Republican State Central Committee chair are
- 19 among the many esteemed positions he held. He also built a storied
- 20 career as an attorney; and
- 21 Whereas, A giant in the fields of law, politics, and public
- 22 service, Lawrence Lindemer is an illustrious representative of the
- 23 Legislature and the state. His family can take great pride in his
- 24 contributions and achievements; now, therefore, be it
- 25 Resolved by the House of Representatives, That we offer this
- 26 expression of our highest tribute to honor the memory of Lawrence
- 27 B. Lindemer, a member of this legislative body from 1951 to 1952;

- 29 Resolved, That copies of this resolution be transmitted to the

1 Lindemer family as evidence of our lasting esteem for his memory.
