SUMMARY:

House Bill 4691 would add a new section to 1978 PA 472, also known as the lobbyist registration act, to provide that a person required to file a report under the act is ineligible for any civil appointment in Michigan from the governor, legislature, or any other state authority, not including an appointment as a notary public, unless the attorney general determines that the appointment would not result in a conflict of interest.

The bill would take effect January 1, 2022.
