SUMMARY:

House Bill 4980 would amend the Michigan Vehicle Code to allow *drag racing* at Silver Lake State Park.

Drag race means the operation of two or more vehicles from a point side by side at accelerating speeds in a competitive attempt to out-distance each other over a common selected course or where timing is involved or where timing devices are used in competitive accelerations of speeds by participating vehicles.

The code currently prohibits drag racing on a highway or any other place open to the general public, including parking lots. The bill would add a single exception for the Silver Lake State Park scramble area.¹

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 4980 is unlikely to affect costs or revenues for the Department of Natural Resources or local governments.
