SUMMARY:

House Bill 5327 would amend the Michigan Memorial Highway Act to designate the portion of highway US-127 in Ingham County from the Kipp Road exit to the highway I-96 interchange as the “Trooper Starr Memorial Highway.”

Currently, the act designates US-127 in Ingham County as the “James M. Pelton Firefighters Memorial Highway.” The designation of a portion of US-127 in honor of Trooper Caleb Starr as described above would be in addition to, and would not replace, that current designation.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Section 2 of the Michigan Memorial Highway Act indicates that the state transportation department shall provide for the erection of suitable markers indicating the name of the highway only “when sufficient private contributions are received to completely cover the cost of erecting and maintaining those markers.” As a result, the bill has no state or local fiscal impact.
