SUMMARY:

Complete to 6-9-21

House Bill 4920 would add a new section to 1846 RS 2 ("Of the legislature") to require, notwithstanding a court order to the contrary, that if a settlement agreement providing for the payment of money is entered following a claim of sexual assault or sexual harassment committed by a *legislator*, the Senate or House of Representatives must upon request make available to the public the name of the legislator identified in the claim and the amount of the settlement. The bill would apply to a settlement agreement entered into on or after the bill's effective date.

Legislator would mean a member of the Michigan Senate or House of Representatives.
