SUMMARY:

House Bill 6187 would repeal section 62507 of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, which currently authorizes the supervisor of mineral wells, acting directly or through a deputy or authorized representative, to issue emergency orders without a public hearing to implement Part 3 (Management of Nonrenewable Resources) of the act. Currently, emergency orders issued under this provision remain in force and effect for not more than 21 days.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 6187 is unlikely to affect cost or revenues for the Department of Natural Resources or local governments.
