SUMMARY:

House Bill 6198 would add a new section to the Michigan Occupational Safety and Health Act (MIOSHA). Currently, the Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity (LEO) may, after determining that an imminent danger exists in a place of employment, issue an order to avoid, correct, or remove the imminent danger. If the employer fails to promptly comply with the order, the department is required to petition the circuit having jurisdiction to restrain a condition or practice in the place of employment determined to cause the imminent danger. The bill would add that the department is required to submit a written notice to the clerk of the House of Representatives and the secretary of the Senate that includes, at a minimum, the details of the department's petition.

FISCAL IMPACT:

House Bill 6198 would have a negligible fiscal impact on the Department of Labor and Economic Opportunity, given the limited number of notices that the department would need to submit. The bill would not have a fiscal impact on any other units of state or local government.
