## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4687

## A bill to amend 1978 PA 472, entitled

"An act to regulate political activity; to regulate lobbyists, lobbyist agents, and lobbying activities; to require registration of lobbyists and lobbyist agents; to require the filing of reports; to prescribe the powers and duties of the department of state; to prescribe penalties; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 6a (MCL 4.416a), as added by 1994 PA 383.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 6a. (1) A member of the Michigan senate or house of
- 2 representatives who resigns from office before January 1, 2023
- 3 shall not make expenditures for or receive compensation or
- 4 reimbursement for actual expenses for lobbying for the remainder of
- 5 the term of office from which the person resigned.

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(2) For 2 years after leaving or resigning from office, a

- 1 former member of the Michigan senate or house of representatives
- 2 shall not make expenditures for or receive compensation or
- 3 reimbursement for actual expenses for lobbying that equal or exceed
- 4 the limit established to require registration as a lobbyist agent.
- 5 This subsection applies to a member whose term of office begins on
- 6 or after January 1, 2023.
- 7 (3) (2) A person An individual who violates this section is
- 8 guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more than
- 9 \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of
- 10 not more than \$1,000.00, or both.
