A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled
"The revised school code,"
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1138a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1138a. (1) Notwithstanding any provision of this act to
2 the contrary, if a public school pupil enrolled in grades 6 to 12
3 is absent from school for up to 1 full school day because the pupil
4 is sounding "Taps" at a military honors funeral held in this state
5 for a deceased veteran, the school officials of the public school

1 shall consider that absence to be an excused absence.
2 Notwithstanding any provision of this act to the contrary, the
3 board of a school district or intermediate school district or board
4 of directors of a public school academy shall ensure that its
5 attendance policy is consistent with this section.

6 (2) As used in this section, "veteran" means that term as
7 defined in section 1 of 1965 PA 190, MCL 35.61.

8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
9 after the date it is enacted into law.
