A bill to amend 1976 PA 442, entitled "Freedom of information act," (MCL 15.231 to 15.246) by adding sections 26, 27, 28, and 29. THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 26. Subject to sections 27 and 28, the council

2 administrator shall designate an individual as the LORA coordinator 3 for all public bodies.

- 4 Sec. 27. The house of representatives may designate an
- 5 individual as the LORA coordinator for the house of

1 representatives.

Sec. 28. The senate may designate an individual as the LORA
coordinator for the senate.

4 Sec. 29. A LORA coordinator may designate another individual 5 to act on his or her behalf in accepting and processing requests 6 for the public body's public records and in approving a denial 7 under section 25.

8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect January9 1, 2022.

10 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect 11 unless Senate Bill No.____ or House Bill No. 4383 (request no. 12 00260'21 *) of the 101st Legislature is enacted into law.
