

# HOUSE BILL NO. 5183

June 30, 2021, Introduced by Rep. Tate and referred to the Committee on Oversight.

A bill to amend 2020 PA 366, entitled

"An act to prohibit postsecondary educational institutions in this state and certain athletic organizations from preventing a college athlete from receiving compensation for the use of his or her name, image, or likeness rights,"

by amending sections 9 and 11 (MCL 390.1739 and 390.1741); and by repealing enacting section 1.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 9. (1) By December 31, 2020 and by December 31, 2021, any  
2   nonprofit trade association that represents postsecondary

educational institutions in this state shall provide for each of those years, respectively, a written summary of both of the following to the chair of the appropriations committee of the house of representatives, the chair of the appropriations committee of the senate, and the chair of the ways and means committee of the house of representatives:

(a) Progress made by the National Collegiate Athletic Association toward the development of a national policy, including updates to relevant bylaws and rules, on student athlete name, image, and likeness compensation, as directed by that association's board of governors on October 29, 2019.

(b) Congressional action on legislation on student athlete name, image, and likeness compensation, including, but not limited to, the proposed congressional advisory commission on intercollegiate athletics act of 2019, as proposed by H.R. 5528 of the 116th Congress.

(2) By June 30, ~~2022~~, **2021**, any nonprofit trade association that represents postsecondary educational institutions in this state shall provide to the chair of the appropriations committee of the house of representatives, the chair of the appropriations committee of the senate, and the chair of the ways and means committee of the house of representatives a written summary of the preparedness of the association's respective member institutions toward implementation of this act.

Sec. 11. (1) ~~Sections~~ **This section and section 9 and 11 of this act** take effect on ~~the date it is enacted into law.~~ **December 31, 2020.**

(2) Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 10 ~~of this act~~ take effect ~~December 31, 2022.~~ **July 31, 2021.**
