A bill to amend 1987 PA 96, entitled "The mobile home commission act," by amending the title and section 3 (MCL 125.2303).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

TITLE

An act to create a mobile home manufactured housing

commission; to prescribe its powers and duties and those of local

governments; to provide for a mobile home code and the licensure,

regulation, construction, operation, and management of mobile home

A vacancy in the office of a member shall of the commission must be filled by the governor for the remainder of the unexpired term, not more than 1 month after the vacancy is created, and in the same manner as the original appointment.
- (6) The legislature shall establish annually a per diem compensation of for the members of the commission and the a schedule for reimbursement of expenses. shall be established annually by the legislature.
- (7) Six members of the commission constitute a quorum for all purposes, notwithstanding the existence of a vacancy in the commission's membership. Action may be taken by the commission by a vote of a majority of the members appointed and serving. Meetings of the commission may be called by the chairperson or by 3 members of the commission on 3 business days' actual notice. At least 1 meeting shall—must be held each calendar quarter. The commission may hold meetings anywhere in this state.
- (8) The commission shall elect a member of the commission as its chairperson and another member as its vice-chairperson. The chairperson or vice-chairperson must be selected from the commission members described in subsection (3)(a) or (g). The duties and powers of the chairperson and vice-chairperson shall
