## **HOUSE BILL NO. 5635**

December 09, 2021, Introduced by Reps. Carra, Bezotte, Paquette, Meerman, Maddock, Steven Johnson, Markkanen and LaFave and referred to the Committee on Workforce, Trades, and Talent.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

by amending section 1233 (MCL 380.1233), as amended by 2018 PA 418.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1233. (1) Except as otherwise provided by law, and
- 2 subject to sections 1233b and 1233c, the board of a school district
- 3 or intermediate school district shall not permit a teacher who does
- 4 not hold a valid teaching certificate to teach in a grade or
- 5 department of the school.
- **6** (2) The board of a school district or intermediate school

- 1 district shall not allow an individual to serve in a counseling
- 2 role in the school district or intermediate school district, as the
- 3 role is defined by the superintendent of public instruction, unless
- 4 the individual meets 1 or more of the following:

- 5 (a) The individual holds a valid teaching certificate with a6 school counseling endorsement.
  - (b) The individual meets all of the following:
- 8 (i) Holds a master's degree awarded after completion of an9 approved school counselor education program that includes at least
- 10 all of the following skills and content areas or their equivalent:
- 11 (A) Guidance services--philosophy, principles, and practices.
- (B) Individual and group analysis—nature and range of humancharacteristics and appraisal methods.
- 14 (C) Guidance information—vocational development theory,15 educational and occupational information.
- 16 (D) Counseling theory and practice--individual and group
  17 procedures, administration and coordination relationships,
  18 professional relationships, and ethics.
- 19 (E) Supervised experiences--laboratory, practicum, or
  20 internship.
- 21 (F) Evaluation--statistics and research methodology, follow-up 22 evaluation, and measurement methods.
- (ii) Has successfully completed the department's guidancecounselor examination.
- (iii) Has been recommended by an approved school counseloreducation program to provide services as a school counselor.
  - (c) The individual meets both of the following:
- 28 (i) Has at least 5 years of successful experience serving in a
  29 school counseling role in another state within the immediately

- 2 (ii) Has successfully completed the department's guidance3 counselor examination.
- 4 (3) Except for teachers engaged to teach under section 1233b
  5 and teachers engaged to teach in a community district under section
  6 1233c, the intermediate superintendent shall notify the
- 7 superintendent of public instruction immediately of the names of
- 8 noncertificated teachers teaching in violation of subsection (1)
- 9 and the names of individuals serving in counseling roles in
- 10 violation of subsection (2), the employing district, and the amount
- 11 of time the noncertificated teachers or unqualified individuals
- 12 were employed.

- 13 (4) A vocational teacher preparation institution shall utilize 14 the employment experience of an annually authorized teacher for the 15 purpose of waiving student teaching as a requirement for vocational 16 certification if the annually authorized teacher is supervised by 17 the teacher preparation institution.
  - (5) The board of a school district or intermediate school district may employ an individual without a teaching certificate as a substitute teacher if either of the following requirements are—is met, if applicable:
- (a) The individual has at least 60 semester hours of college credit or an associate degree from a college, university, or community college. The 60 semester hours do not need to be from the same college, university, or community college.at least a high school diploma or a high school equivalency certificate as that term is defined in section 4 of the state school aid act of 1979, MCL 388.1604.
  - (b) For substitute teaching a course in an industrial

- 1 technology education program or a career and technical education
- 2 program, the individual is engaged to substitute teach in a subject
- 3 matter or field in which the individual has achieved expertise, as
- 4 determined by the board of a school district or intermediate school
- 5 district and satisfies all of the following, if applicable:
- 6 (i) Has a high school diploma or a high school equivalency
- 7 certificate as that term is defined in section 4 of the state
- 8 school aid act of 1979, MCL 388.1604.
- $\mathbf{9}$  (ii) For substitute teaching in a subject matter or field in
- 10 which a professional license or certification is required, at least
- 11 1 of the following:
- 12 (A) Holds a professional license or certification in that same
- 13 subject matter or field.
- 14 (B) Previously held a professional license or certification in
- 15 that same subject matter or field that expired not more than 2
- 16 years before the noncertificated substitute teacher's initial
- 17 employment under this section and was in good standing immediately
- 18 before the license or certification expired.
- 19 (iii) Has at least 2 cumulative years of professional experience
- 20 in that same subject matter or field in the immediately preceding
- **21** 10 years.
- 22 (6) Beginning February 6, 2020, the The department shall not
- 23 renew an individual's school counselor credential unless the
- 24 department determines that, within the time period since the
- 25 individual's school counselor credential was issued or last
- 26 renewed, whichever is most recent, the individual has completed at
- 27 least 25 hours of professional development approved by the
- 28 department under subsection (8) covering counseling about the
- 29 college preparation and selection process and at least 25 hours of

- 1 professional development approved by the department under
- 2 subsection (8) covering career counseling. For the purposes of this
- 3 subsection, career counseling includes, but is not limited to,
- 4 exploration of military career options and the skilled trades as
- 5 well as other careers and pathways that lead to industry
- 6 credentials awarded in recognition of an individual's attainment of
- 7 measurable technical or occupational skills necessary to obtain
- 8 employment or advance within an occupation. The hours of
- 9 professional development required under this subsection covering
- 10 career counseling must include at least 5 hours covering military
- 11 career options. The hours of professional development required
- 12 under this subsection are a part of and not in addition to
- 13 professional development requirements under department rule.
- 14 (7) An individual may complete the professional development
- 15 hours for the purposes of subsection (6) as part of the
- 16 professional development provided by a school district,
- 17 intermediate school district, public school academy, or nonpublic
- 18 school under section 1527 if the content and curriculum of the
- 19 professional development provided under section 1527 are approved
- 20 by the department under subsection (8).
- 21 (8) The department shall approve the professional development
- 22 for the purposes of subsection (6). The department shall only
- 23 approve a professional development program or course for the
- 24 purposes of subsection (6) if the department determines that the
- 25 content and curriculum for the professional development meet
- 26 standards that are developed by the department in consultation with
- 27 the department of talent and economic development labor and
- 28 economic opportunity and groups representing school counselors,
- 29 college admissions professionals, financial aid officers,

- 1 employers, and others as determined appropriate by the department.
- 2 The department shall develop these standards by July 1, 2018 and
- 3 shall facilitate the involvement in the development of the
- 4 standards of the groups required under this subsection.
- 5 (9) The superintendent of public instruction shall promulgate
- 6 or modify rules as necessary to implement subsections (6) to (8).
