

HOUSE BILL NO. 5673

January 18, 2022, Introduced by Reps. Cynthia Johnson, Rabhi, Brenda Carter, Thanedar, Brabec, Tyrone Carter, Hood, Whitsett, Jones and Yancey and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for various state departments and agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022; to provide for certain conditions on appropriations; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

GENERAL SECTIONS

12 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state
13 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under
14 part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022 is \$0.00 and
15 total state spending from state sources to be paid to local units
16 of government is \$0.00.

17 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
18 under this part and part 1 and the departments, commissions,
19 boards, offices, and programs for which appropriations are made
20 under this part and part 1 are subject to the management and budget
21 act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY

24 Sec. 301. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 for racial equity
25 and reparations fund must be deposited into the racial equity and
26 reparations fund created in section 3 of the racial equity and
27 reparations fund act.

28 (2) From the funds appropriated in part 1 for racial equity
29 and reparations fund, the department of treasury shall provide

1 grants, loans, investments, and other economic assistance for
2 businesses and economic developments that promote the African-
3 American community in this state.

4 (3) The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for racial
5 equity and reparations fund are designated as a work project
6 appropriation. Unencumbered or unallotted funds shall not lapse at
7 the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for expenditures
8 under this section until the project has been completed. The
9 following is in compliance with section 451a of the management and
10 budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:

11 (a) The purpose of the project is to provide grants, loans,
12 investments, and other economic assistance for businesses and for
13 economic developments that promote the African-American community
14 in this state.

15 (b) The project will be accomplished by utilizing state
16 employees, contracts with vendors, or local partners.

17 (c) The estimated cost of the project is \$1,500,000,000.00.

18 (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2026.

19 (4) Funds appropriated in part 1 for racial equity and reparations
20 fund must not be spent or otherwise distributed unless Senate Bill No.____
21 or House Bill No. 5674 (request no. 04840'21) of the 101st Legislature is
22 enacted into law.
