THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 18818. Except as otherwise provided in section 18818a, a
- 2 veterinarian shall not engage in the practice of veterinary
- 3 medicine unless it is within the context of a veterinarian-client-
- 4 patient relationship. Subject to federal law, all of the following
- 5 requirements must be met for a veterinarian-client-patient

- 2 (a) The veterinarian must assume responsibility for making 3 clinical judgments regarding the health of the animal and the need 4 for medical treatment and its owner must have agreed to follow the 5 veterinarian's instructions.
- 6 (b) The veterinarian must have sufficient knowledge of the 7 animal to initiate, at a minimum, a general or preliminary 8 diagnosis of the medical condition of the animal.
 - (c) The veterinarian must be readily available, or must arrange for emergency coverage, for a follow-up evaluation in the event of an adverse reaction or the failure of the treatment regimen.
 - (d) The veterinarian must have recently examined the animal in person or obtained current knowledge of the animal through the use of instrumentation and diagnostic equipment through which images and medical records may be transmitted electronically or through a referral from another veterinarian.
