## **HOUSE BILL NO. 6135**

May 24, 2022, Introduced by Reps. Yaroch, Bezotte, Allor, Borton and Beson and referred to the Committee on Elections and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending section 683 (MCL 168.683), as amended by 2018 PA 120.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 683. (1) Each county clerk before each primary and
- 2 election shall, by some reliable means, notify the clerk of each
- 3 township and city in the county of a training school for election
- 4 inspectors to be held at a place designated by the county clerk
- 5 within 20 days before each primary, general, and special election.

1 The township and city clerks shall notify each election inspector

- 2 appointed to serve at that election of the time and place of the
- 3 training school. At the meeting, the county clerk shall instruct
- 4 and demonstrate the manner in which the duties of election
- 5 inspectors are required by law to be performed. It is the duty of
- 6 the The election inspectors, so notified, to must attend the
- 7 meeting unless excused by the county clerk for good cause.
- 8 Compensation may be paid to them by their respective municipalities
- 9 at a rate as determined by the governing bodies. An election
- 10 inspector shall not serve in any election unless he or she has
- 11 within the last preceding 2 years either attended an election
- 12 school or has passed satisfactorily an examination given by the
- 13 election commission of the city or township in which appointed. The
- 14 examination is subject to the approval of the secretary of state.
- 15 This section does not prevent the appointment of an election
- 16 inspector to fill a vacancy.
- 17 (2) This section does not prohibit any city or any township
- 18 having a population of 10,000 or more from conducting its own
- 19 training school for election inspectors of that city or township if
- 20 the clerk of that city or township meets both of the following
- 21 requirements:
- 22 (a) Has achieved certification as a certified Michigan
- 23 municipal clerk by the Michigan Association of Municipal Clerks.
- 24 (b) Has conducted at least 1 election.
- 25 (3) If a city or township conducts its own training school as
- 26 provided under subsection (2), election inspectors who attend a
- 27 city or township training school are not required to attend the
- 28 county training school.
