(1) A vendor who is not an insurance producer shall not sell or offer coverage under a portable electronics insurance policy to a customer unless the vendor is a limited line portable electronics insurance producer. A license issued to a vendor under this chapter authorizes any employee or authorized representative of the vendor to sell or offer coverage under a policy of portable electronics insurance to a customer at any location at which the

- vendor engages in portable electronics transactions.

 (2) The supervising entity shall maintain a registry of

 locations that are authorized to sell or solicit portable

 electronics insurance in this state. On the director's request and
