

HOUSE BILL NO. 6243

June 16, 2022, Introduced by Reps. Aiyash and Rabhi and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for various state departments and agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022; to provide for certain conditions on appropriations; and to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations.

PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

GENERAL SECTIONS

11 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state
12 constitution of 1963, total state spending from state sources under
13 part 1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2022 is \$500,000.00
14 and total state spending from state sources to be paid to local
15 units of government is \$0.00.

16 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and expenditures authorized
17 under this part and part 1 and the departments, commissions,
18 boards, offices, and programs for which appropriations are made
19 under this part and part 1 are subject to the management and budget
20 act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL RIGHTS

23 Sec. 301. (1) Funds appropriated in part 1 for Michigan fair
24 chance access to housing must be used by the department of civil
25 rights to implement and administer the Michigan fair chance access
26 to housing act. Funds may be used to hire staff to process and
27 investigate complaints under the act.

28 (2) The unexpended funds appropriated in part 1 for Michigan
29 fair chance access to housing are designated as a work project

1 appropriation. Any unencumbered or unallotted funds shall not lapse
2 at the end of the fiscal year and shall be available for
3 expenditures for projects under this section until the projects
4 have been completed. The following is in compliance with section
5 451a of the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1451a:

6 (a) The purpose of the project is to implement and administer
7 the Michigan fair chance access to housing act.

8 (b) The project will be accomplished by utilizing state
9 employees or contracts, or both.

10 (c) The total estimated cost of the project is \$500,000.00.

11 (d) The tentative completion date is September 30, 2026.
