"An act to prohibit a local government or law enforcement agency from operating a motor vehicle storage facility or towing operation; to prohibit a local government or law enforcement agency from accepting consideration from an authorized vendor that operates a motor vehicle storage facility; to prohibit a local government or law enforcement agency from requiring an authorized vendor to deliver a motor vehicle to a motor vehicle storage facility operated by a different authorized vendor; to provide for exceptions; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state and local departments, entities, and officials; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain law enforcement agencies; and to provide for remedies and penalties,"

by amending sections 1 and 2 (MCL 123.1401 and 123.1402) and by

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Authorized vendor" means an individual or entity that a
- 3 local government or law enforcement agency designates through
- 4 contract, permit, practice, or license to have authority to remove
- 5 or store motor vehicles at the request of the local government or
- 6 law enforcement agency.
- 7 (b) "Jurisdictional area" means the area within the
- 8 jurisdiction of a department of state police post.
- 9 (c) (b)—"Law enforcement agency" means the department of state
- 10 police, the department of natural resources, or a law enforcement
- 11 agency of a county, township, city, village, or airport authority,
- 12 that is responsible for the prevention and detection of crime and

- (a) Operate a motor vehicle storage facility or towing

- 5 (c) Require an authorized vendor to deliver a motor vehicle to6 a motor vehicle storage facility operated by a different authorized7 vendor.
- 8 Sec. 3b. (1) The department of technology, management, and 9 budget shall enter into a contract with an authorized vendor to 10 provide motor vehicle storage facilities and towing operations on 11 behalf of the department of state police in each jurisdictional 12 area. The department of state police shall use an authorized vendor 13 within each jurisdictional area to provide the services described 14 in this subsection.
- 15 (2) Before entering into or renewing a contract described
 16 under subsection (1), the department of technology, management, and
 17 budget shall, in accordance with the management and budget act,
 18 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594, issue a request for
 19 qualifications for the purpose of selecting an authorized vendor to
 20 operate a motor vehicle storage facility or towing operation in
 21 each jurisdictional area.
 - (3) The department of technology, management, and budget shall follow the standard public procurement process as provided in the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594, when issuing the request for qualifications under subsection (2).
