THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 21d. (1) If a defendant is charged with a crime in connection with a firearm the defendant owns, or for which the defendant is a legal authorized user, because another individual used the firearm in the commission of a crime, the defendant has a complete defense to the crime with which the defendant is charged

- 1 if the defendant presents evidence of all of the following
- 2 regarding the firearm:
- 3 (a) It was legally obtained.
- 4 (b) It was legally owned.
- 5 (c) It was properly stored.
- 6 (2) A prosecutor may overcome the defense under subsection (1)
- 7 if the evidence demonstrates, beyond a reasonable doubt, that the
- 8 firearm was not legally obtained, legally owned, or properly
- 9 stored.
- 10 (3) As used in this section:
- 11 (a) "Active firearm" means a firearm that is loaded with
- 12 ammunition.
- 13 (b) "Crime" includes a felony or misdemeanor violation of the
- 14 laws of this state or a misdemeanor violation of the laws of a

- 16 (c) "Legal authorized user" means an individual to whom the
- 17 owner of the firearm has provided unambiguous or direct permission
- 18 to use or possess the firearm.
- (d) "Nonactive firearm" means a firearm that is not loaded
- 20 with ammunition.
- 21 (e) "Properly stored" means either of the following:
- 22 (i) With respect to an active firearm, the firearm is kept
- 23 inside a locked container within such close proximity of the owner
- 24 or other legal authorized user that the owner or legal authorized
- 25 user can readily retrieve and use the firearm in the same manner as
- 26 if the owner or legal authorized user is carrying the firearm on
- 27 the owner or legal authorized user's person. The owner or legal
- 28 authorized user must remain in immediate proximity and control of
- 29 an active firearm. An active firearm may also be kept inside a

- 1 locked container, in a locked safe, vault, or other secured
- 2 container designed for expedited retrieval and possible use. An
- 3 active firearm that is a pistol may be temporarily stored in a
- 4 concealed portion of a locked trunk, a locked glovebox inside a
- 5 locked vehicle, or a locked center console inside a locked vehicle
- 6 if the properly licensed owner is entering a location that is a
- 7 weapon free school zone as that term is defined in section 237a of
- 8 the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.237a, or other gun-
- 9 free zone under the laws of this state, a political subdivision of
- 10 this state, or the United States. An owner or legal authorized user
- 11 does not breach the owner or legal authorized user's duty to
- 12 properly store an active firearm if the owner or legal authorized
- 13 user is the victim of any criminal intent or action to gain access
- 14 to the owner or legal authorized user's firearm or the subject of
- 15 an active and willful search by another individual resulting in the
- 16 unauthorized acquisition or forced surrender by the owner or other
- 17 legal authorized user of the firearm.
- 18 (ii) With respect to a nonactive firearm, the firearm is stored
- 19 inside a locked container, is locked with the use of a trigger
- 20 lock, cable lock, padlock between rear of trigger and trigger
- 21 guard, or other locking system that renders the firearm inoperable,
- 22 and is separated from ammunition. A nonactive firearm, and its
- 23 ammunition, must be stored in a secured or locked gun safe or
- 24 vault, or a locked and hardened cabinet, drawer, storage closet, or
- 25 room. Keys or lock combinations must also be unavailable to any
- 26 other individual but the owner and a legal authorized user. A
- 27 nonactive firearm may also be stored in a disassembled state with
- 28 the firearm body separated from the firing mechanism so that the
- 29 firearm is inoperable or will not hold or fire ammunition.
