A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1308c.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 1308c. (1) The board of a school district or intermediate school district or board of directors of a public school academy shall ensure that each school building operated by the board or board of directors is equipped with at least 1 panic alarm for use in a school security emergency, including, but not limited to, a

- 1 nonfire evacuation, a lockdown, or an active-shooter situation. The
- 2 panic alarm described in this subsection must be directly linked to
- 3 the local law enforcement agency that is designated as a first
- 4 responder for the school building in which the panic alarm is
- 5 included, and the panic alarm must be capable of immediately
- 6 transmitting a signal or message to the local law enforcement
- 7 agency upon its activation.
- 8 (2) As used in this section:
- 9 (a) "Panic alarm" means a silent security system signal
- 10 generated by the manual activation of a device or an alternative
- 11 mechanism intended to communicate life-threatening or emergency
- 12 situations that require a response from law enforcement to law

- 14 (b) "School building" means a building in which instruction
- 15 takes place or where pupils are present during the school day.
